| Local Area for Play (LAP) | These areas are integral part of the design process for all new housing developments, A LAP is designed for very young children up to the age of 6 years, to play close to where they live (within 1 minute walking time). Its primary function is to encourage informal play and social interaction. The size of the area is usually 100m ^{2.,} The area does not need to be equipped. (LAPS in Gillingham are equipped with public seating plus one or two 'springers' for toddlers). | | | |
| Local Equipped Area for Play (LEAP) | These areas are intended for children who are beginning to go out and play independently. It is usually with five minutes walk from home and is usually 400m ² . These areas need to be equipped. | | | |
