The Civic Hall formerly the Magistrates Court built in 1890, is a large room with a high ceiling and a small raised stage.

The room holds 60 people closely seated. There is a small walled garden suitable for photographs at the rear of the building.



All rooms have wheelchair access and there is a small car park to the side of the building with limited parking during the week.

The Jubilee Room



Primarily used for council meetings, this room is ideal for meetings. The room has a hearing loop, projector, screen and wheelchair access.

It can seat 18 people around the fixed tables with further seating to the rear of the room for 28 people.

There is a small kitchen separate to the Jubilee Room, equipped with cups, saucers, kettles and hot water flasks.

A small meeting room for up to 10 people, located next to Gillingham Library. It is equipped with cups, saucers and a kettle. There is a pay and display car park located at the rear of the building.
