The Committee Clerk referred to the Gillingham Conservation Area Appraisal document and informed the meeting that a site visit had taken place on Thursday 28th June with the Heritage Consultant and an action plan of work has been drawn up.

The Chairman asked if a time-frame had been set.

The Committee Clerk stated that it is hoped to complete the work by mid-August
