486. To receive and accept apologies for absence.

It was agreed and **RESOLVED** to accept the apologies received from Cllr A von Clemens and Cllr Frith as they were unable to attend the meeting due to a previous commitment.

489. To receive and consider a report from the Estate Management Sub-Committee regarding the transfer of public open space at the following:

a) Barnaby Mead

Cllr B von Clemens informed the meeting that, at the present time, due to insufficient information, it would not be possible to consider the transfer of public open space at Barnaby Mead. The matter will be considered as soon as further information is received from the developer.

b) Lodden Lakes Housing Development Phase One.

The following documentation had been circulated prior to the meeting:

- A copy of the s106 Agreement dated 22nd May 2015
- A confidential report outlining the negotiations
- Full and detailed costings

It was unanimously agreed and **RESOLVED** that the current offer from Taylor Wimpey to pay £25,000 for the transfer of the Public Open Space (POS) and the Biodiversity Buffer Zone (BBZ) is rejected and the Town Clerk is authorised to communicate that to the developer.
