Request for Suggested Street Names for New Development in Gillingham

Background

In January 2024, the Town Council were asked by Redrow Homes to suggest an initial 6/7 street names for the first phase of the new development based on a theme of local importance.

Several themes were considered by the Planning Committee, and it was agreed that The Gillingham Pottery, Brick and Tile Company who manufactured bricks, tiles, drain-pipes and terracotta between 1865 and 1969 close to this site, should form the basis for the theme.

At the planning meeting on 8th January 2024 the following names were recommended to Redrow:

Potters Place Masonry Court
Kiln Lane Tile Twist Close
Brickwork Avenue Red Brick Lane
Tile Terrace Pottery Way

In July 2024, Places for People proposed precious stones as the theme for their development on the land south of Shaftesbury Road. At the Planning Meeting the 8th July, the Committee considered and approved the following names:

Emerald Lane Sapphire Drive Diamond Close Ruby Lane Jasper Close Amber Lane Coral Lane

An email from Redrow was received on 7 August 2024 requesting 6 new names, to cover the next phase.
