
Throughout the year I will be promoting local groups in need of volunteers, so if you are looking for new members, then email me with the information and I will promote your groups at a full council meeting.

A NEW COUNCIL FOR GILLINGHAM

In May 2019 a new term of office began. A Notice of Election was published on 15 March 2019 and Gillingham Town Council held open evenings for those interested in standing for election.

Completed nomination papers were submitted to the Returning Officer and following the deadline on 3 April 2019, Gillingham had one contested ward in Wyke. The Town Ward received only six nominations for nine seats; there were no nominations for the Ham Ward and the Milton-on-Stour and Rural Wards were uncontested.



Following the close of nominations, Gillingham Town Council was left with 5 vacant seats (two seats in Ham and three seats in Town). The council were required to fill these vacancies by co-option within 35 days from 6 May.

Gillingham Town Council now has a full complement of 17 councillors who will serve a five year term from May 2019 to May 2024.

TRIBUTES FOR RETIRING COUNCILLORS

Tributes have been paid to five members of the previous council at the end of their term on office.

Su Hunt, Mayor of Gillingham in 1996, 1999, 2010 and 2018, awarded Freeman of Gillingham in 2010. After an incredible 28 years of service to our town Su has decided to retire. Her devotion and loyalty to our town will never be forgotten.

Anne Beckley joined the town council in 2003 and has been totally dedicated to the council. Anne has represented the town on issues such as the health and wellbeing and local history and her knowledge and understanding of our countryside has been invaluable. After 16 years of service to our town, Anne has decided to retire.

David Walsh joined the town council in 2010. In 2015 David served as Mayor of Gillingham and following 9 years of service to the town council, he is now moving on and will be serving as a councillor for Dorset Council.

Belinda Ridout joined the town council in 2011 and has been the driving force behind many of our projects. Belinda served as Mayor of Gillingham in 2011 and following 8 years of service to Gillingham Town Council, she is moving on and will now be serving as a councillor for Dorset Council.

Nicky Purkis represented the rural ward for four years; was a committed member of the planning committee and fought for affordable housing for Gillingham.

Tributes have also been paid to **Steve Joyce** who served as Mayor in 2012–2013 and retired in December 2018 after serving for 11 Years.

REDUCING OUR CARBON FOOTPRINT

The Town Council continues to reduce its carbon footprint by changing our working practices and ensuring that environmental issues are considered and implemented, where possible, in all aspects of our business. Our Grounds Team are changing over to battery powered maintenance tools as the old equipment needs replacing.

We will endeavor to ensure that planning applications are scrutinized to ensure that proposed developments are sustainable and that larger developments mitigate environmental impact on surrounding areas by incorporating energy saving initiatives and well -designed amenity spaces that are sympathetic to the natural landscape.

The Biodiversity Action Plans for our larger open spaces will be updated and the areas regularly monitored, which will provide an indication as to whether we have been successful in improving these areas for wildlife, flora and fauna.

On 24 June a group was formed to undertake an audit of the town council's operations and to produce a carbon management plan and programme of action in support of Dorset Council who declared a climate emergency in May

MEMORIAL TESTING AT GILLINGHAM CEMETERY



Gillingham Town Council has а responsibility for public safety at Gillingham Cemetery and annually carry out memorial testing, as unsafe memorials have been the cause of severe injury in cemeteries some across the country.

Town Council staff working at the cemetery understand the importance and significance of the graves and memorials to the remaining family and friends and have received memorial condition training with the Institute of Cemetery and Crematorium Management.

Our trained staff have carried out an inspection programme checking the condition of every memorial. This may have result in unsafe memorials being laid flat to prevent damage or injury. Please be assured that all memorials will be treated with the utmost care and respect.

If a memorial is considered to be unsafe, grave owners will be notified of the outcome as soon as possible, by way of notices on defective graves. The registered owner of the memorial is requested to arrange for repairs to be carried out within twelve months. If the memorial is not repaired within this time, Gillingham Town Council will consider taking appropriate action. Staff are aware that this is a sensitive issue and will do their best to handle situations in a sensitive manner.
