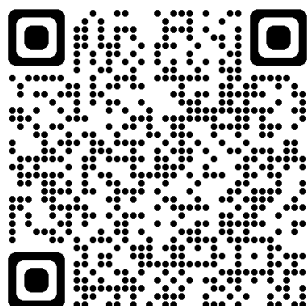

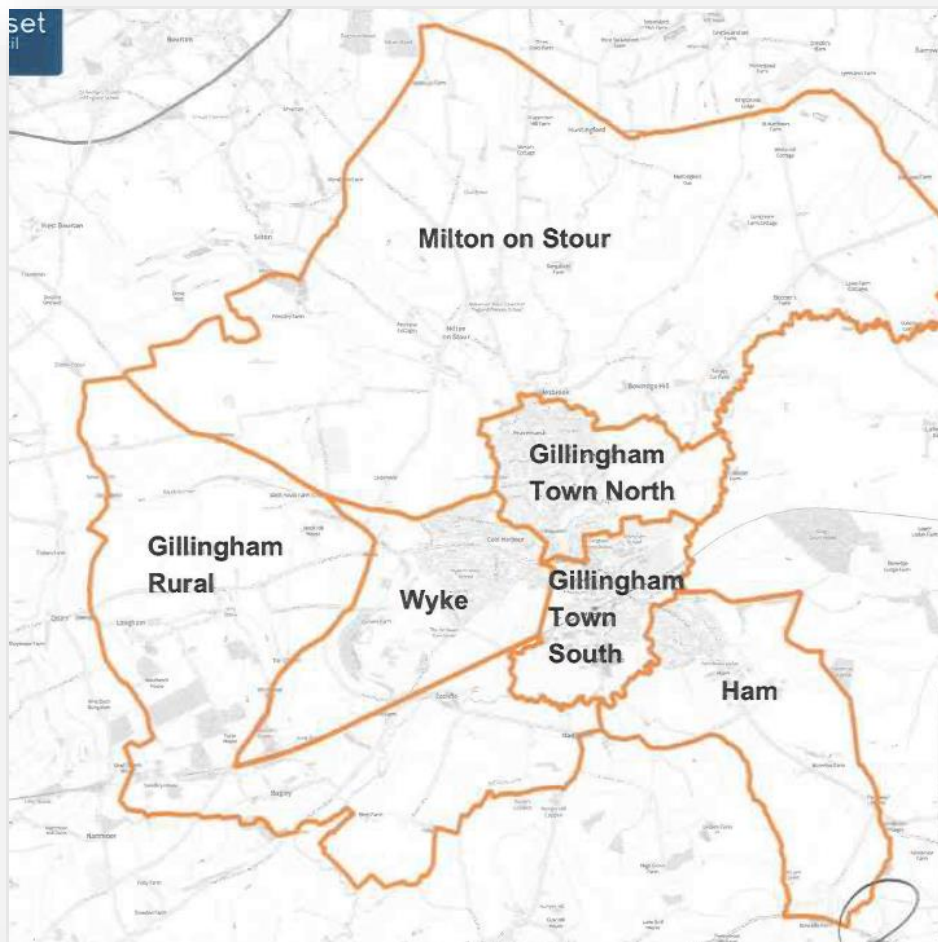

Once you have decided to get involved and stand as a councillor you will need to decide which ward you would like to represent. Please do not hesitate to contact us at Gillingham Town Hall if you would like to discuss this further.



Gillingham will need a total of 18 councillors divided between the wards as follows:

**Ham Ward** - 3 Councillors

**Milton-on-Stour** - 1 Councillor

**Gillingham Rural** - 1 Councillor

**Wyke** - 4 Councillors

**Gillingham Town North** - 6 Councillors

**Gillingham Town South** - 3 Councillors
